mesh pot; leaves lanceolate medium green 4.3 x 45.2 cm;
sepal and petals chartreuse striped cardovan; lip cream;
heavily suffused extremely dark black cardovan;
column, 4 x 1.0 cream spotted central and basally,
anther cap cream; substance firm; texture
matte; origin Central America
