## Clowesia thylaciochila 'Edith' CHM/AOS 82 pts. 20225793

One hundred eighty-four attractive green flowers and 18 buds on four 15.0cm. to 22.0-cm. pendant inflorescences extending basally from two mature, leafless pseudobulbs; plant sympodial, bearing seven closely spaced leafless pseudobulbs and four immature growths, 14.0 cm wide by 10.0 cm tall, grown in sphagnum moss in a 20.0-cm diameter round, 10.0-cm deep plastic pot; 11 leaves, green, immature at time of the award, lower leaves oblong, from 4.6 cm x 1.5 cm to 33.0 cm x 5.0 cm, upper leaves oblanceolate, 43.0 cm long x 3.5 cm wide and 46.5 cm x 3.3 cm, margins smooth, apex mucronate, petioles broad encircling pseudobulbs, 4.0 cm x 4.5 cm to 4.0 cm x 7.0 cm, terminal petioles terminating in sharp spines 0.2 cm to 0.5 cm; pseudobulbs compressed, pyriform, green 10.0 cm tall by 4.0 cm wide at base; inflorescence raceme; dorsal sepal oblong-oblanceolate, cuspidate, translucent white, blushed pale green, veined darker green; lateral sepals falcate-oblong, cuspidate, translucent white, blushed pale green distally, veined darker green; petals broadly oblanceolate, cuspidate, translucent white, blushed pale green medially, veined darker green; lip cesta-shaped, translucent white, suffused light green, yellow-green centrally, veined darker green, apex flat, frilled, raised v-shaped, translucent white ridge, blotched maroon distally, sub-apically; column cream, blushed light green distally, veined translucent white and light green, anther cap lanceolate, truncate, translucent white, revealing yellow pollinia underneath; substance moderate; texture crystalline; country of origin is Mexico; award is provisional pending SITF confirmation; recognized for attractive clusters of green flowers well-displayed on pendant inflorescences.
