upright, sequentially flowering 50-cm inflorescence; plant left on high x 50 cm high with five monopodial growths; leaves linear, smooth, medium green; bracts and ovary cordovan; sepals ovoid, light green, striped darker green, obverse heavily overlaid and striped cordovan; petals lanceolate, twisted, downswept, light green overlaid cordovan distally, cordovan plicate, hirsute basally; hairs red; pouch cream, overlaid light green, blushed cordovan distally, spotted cordovan proximally; staminate deltoid, light green, margins hirsute; substance firm, texture satin, awarded as Phragmipedium

x brasiliense, a natural hybrid form in east Brazil. Award CHM and Score 80
