Description: beginning with number of flowers, buds and inflorescence
(PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY) Eleven stellate flowers on two upright inflorescences up to 13.5-cm long and five buds on developing inflorescence, originating from base of new growth, presented on a 4.5-cm wide by 3.3-cm long plant grown in a 10-cm plastic net pot filled with sphagnum moss, pseudobulbs flattened, ovate closely clustered, up to 3.7-cm wide by 7-cm long; leaves lanceolate up to 3.9-cm wide by 22-cm long, margins smooth, leaf apex acute; spiderly sepals and petals chartreuse, brown blotches proximally with elongated heavy keel basally and bright
