Trisetella escobarii 'Windflower' CHM/AOS 91 pts. 20225771

Five charming flowers and two buds on seven up to 6.7-cm inflorescences presented on an extremely clean, robust plant grown on a 3.0-cm wide by 7.0cm long moss-covered tree fern plaque; leaves broadly ensiform, 3.0 cm long by 0.3 cm wide, fleshy, semi-terete; growths minute, hidden by the abundance of growths; inflorescence has one bract at the halfway point, texture strumose; sepals yellow, dorsal sepal quadrate, proximal half fused to basal margins of lateral sepals forming hood over column, brushed mahogany distally, midvein light mahogany extending on to proximal half of caudae, dorsal caudae 1.0 cm, slightly swollen distally, yellow blushed light mahogany; lateral sepals fused, boat shaped, yellow, midvein and two parallel veins dark mahogany, brushed dark mahogany centrally, very intense distally, lateral caudae yellow, heavily blushed mahogany, 0.6 cm long, slightly swollen distally; petals oval, slightly cupped, apically dentate, porrect, yellow, midvein and two parallel veins dark mahogany; lip white, heavily overlaid dark pink, veined darker pink, white spot centrally; column light

green, ventral surface blushed maroon, dorsal midvein maroon, anther cap light green; ovary green, maroon proximally, strumose; substance firm; texture lightly crystalline, lip waxy; lateral sepals measured as fused.
