

Satyrium coriifolium 'Huntinton's Bouquet'

Twenty-nine resupinate flowers and seven buds on one sturdy, upright 21.0-cm sequentially blooming inflorescence borne on a terrestrial plant grown in a 9.0-cm, square, green plastic pot using a terrestrial mix made of sponge rock and a little organic material; inflorescence segmented, three segments covered by white sheaths; no leaves or growths are in evidence; sepals and petals spathulate, light pink, arrayed as a fan, slight distal recurving, midvein darker pink, dorsal sepal and petals sparsely spotted and blotched dark purple-magenta on proximal half; lip saccate, green basally, spotted magenta, white proximally, light pink distally, distal margin reflexed, veined purple-magenta, two spurs, 1.7 cm long, faint pink proximally, light green distally, pink apically; column white, two papillae on ventral surface at apex, brown distally, anther cap white, muricate; ovary green, cancellate; substance medium; texture finely crystalline; pending SITF verification; recognized for unusual pink color and rarity in cultivation.
