Description: Begin with the number of flowers, buds, and inflorescences

Five beautifully-colored, full flat flowers on one 5.0-cm inflorescence; flowers white; sepals and petals suffused light yellow, overlaid pink, appearing peach; dorsal sepal elliptical, very slightly cupped; lateral sepals ovate; petals spatulate; lip shovel-shaped, flat, golden yellow, proximal margins porrect, proximal crest with three grooves; column four-basal tendrils, filamentous, white, three-ridges, side wings porrect, golden yellow imobile; and anther cap white; substance firm; texture crystalline; leaves (four) dark green, broadly elliptic, 2.2 cm x 3.1 cm, roots slightly flattened; pedicel 1.7 cm, light green.

Provisional due to unusual color and flat, full form for the species.
