Description from entry form: One flower and no buds on one erect 14.5-cm inflorescence, dorsal sepal apple-green overlaid mahogany centrally; synsepal apple-green; petals apple-green basal 1-cm, heavily suffused deep rose-pink remaining 3.7-cm, spotted raspberry superior 2-cm, hirsute margins; pouch olive-green, apple-green rim; staminode pale green, dark green centrally; substance firm; texture glossy. Noted for short stem.
