One 23 cm inflorescence flowers distributed 18 cm above. 36 Bulbs, 7 leafless. Plant 38 cm wide, 15 cm in height; growing in 20 cm tree fern. Flowers dark burgundy; sepals distinct. Petals forshortened & tufted, tongue shaped; lip blue gray. Texture glaucous, substance firm. Recognized for rarity in cultivation and educational value. Endemic to Phillipine Island Luzon, Viti Levu, Fiji.
