**Description:** beginning with the number of flowers and buds and inflorescence

Thirty-nine flowers and 3 buds on two arched green inflorescences upto 13 cm long, originating from base of new growths, on 50 cm diameter 34 growth plant, grown in a bark mix in a 20 cm clay pot; bifoliate pseudobulbs flat ovate, leaves linear 2.7cm by 26 cm, margins entire, apex acute; dorsal sepal and petals linear, apple-green centrally, faint yellow along margins; lateral sepals fused proximal two-thirds apple-green stripe centrally faint yellow along margins; lip broad curved backwards cream basally, distally light chartreuse, two keels white, yellow stripe between keels, two orange spots along column; column cream; anther cap yellow, substance firm, texture matte; noted for nice presentation of interesting colored flowers.
