Dorsal sepal and lip substance heavy, texture waxy. Lateral sepals and petals substance light, texture matte.

Description: beginning with number of flowers, buds and inflorescence (PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY) 15 flowers on one 34cm inflorescence with one additional immature inflorescence. Petals and lateral sepals pale green, stippled burgundy and shading to solid burgundy at the tips. Dorsal sepal hooded, a rich butter yellow, apex apple green. Lip and pollen triggers rich butter yellow. Anther cap deep burgundy. Overall plant 80cm wide by 57cm high in a 5 inch plastic pot with 4 pseudobulbs. Flowering pseudobulb 23cm. Leaves 11cm wide by 55cm length. ISITF- Presented as Catasetum macroglossum but one tag in pot said macrocarpum and after image comparison, judging team determined it was macrocarpum.
