**Description:** beginning with number of flowers, buds and inflorescence

(PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY) 15 flowers, and 5 buds on 20 inflorescence  
originating from new growth, campanulate form,  
sepals and petals are spatulate, base color green  
longitudinally striped and overlaid or black on  
sepals, petals lighter, apex presented on a spread  
80-cm wide x 66-cm tall, plant grown in a 23-cm  
plastic mesh basket in a sphagnum mix. Plant with  
ascending unsheathed rhizomes, pseudobulbs  
flattened ovate, 7.8cm long, 4.5cm in diameter, distance  
between each up to 8-cm, leaves lanceolate 4-cm wide  
x 37-cm long.
