**Description:** Begin with the number of flowers, buds, and inflorescences

Six flowers typical of the species well-arranged alternately on one arched, 27.0-cm inflorescence arising from the basal leaf axil of a bracteate, dorso-ventrally flattened 7.5 x 2.1 x 0.9-cm pseudobulb, growing in a twenty-three growth clean plant, 25-cm white plastic pot, cultivated in bark mix; leaves, trifoliolate, conduplicate, lanceolate, entire; sepals lanceolate, entire, light chartreuse, heavily barred chestnut; petals lanceolate, arcuate, entire, light chartreuse, heavily barred chestnut; lip, spatulate, apically recurved, margins undulate, basally recurved, entire, central and paracentral keels, light chartreuse, spotted chestnut; substance, firm; texture, matte; species endemic to Peru.
